

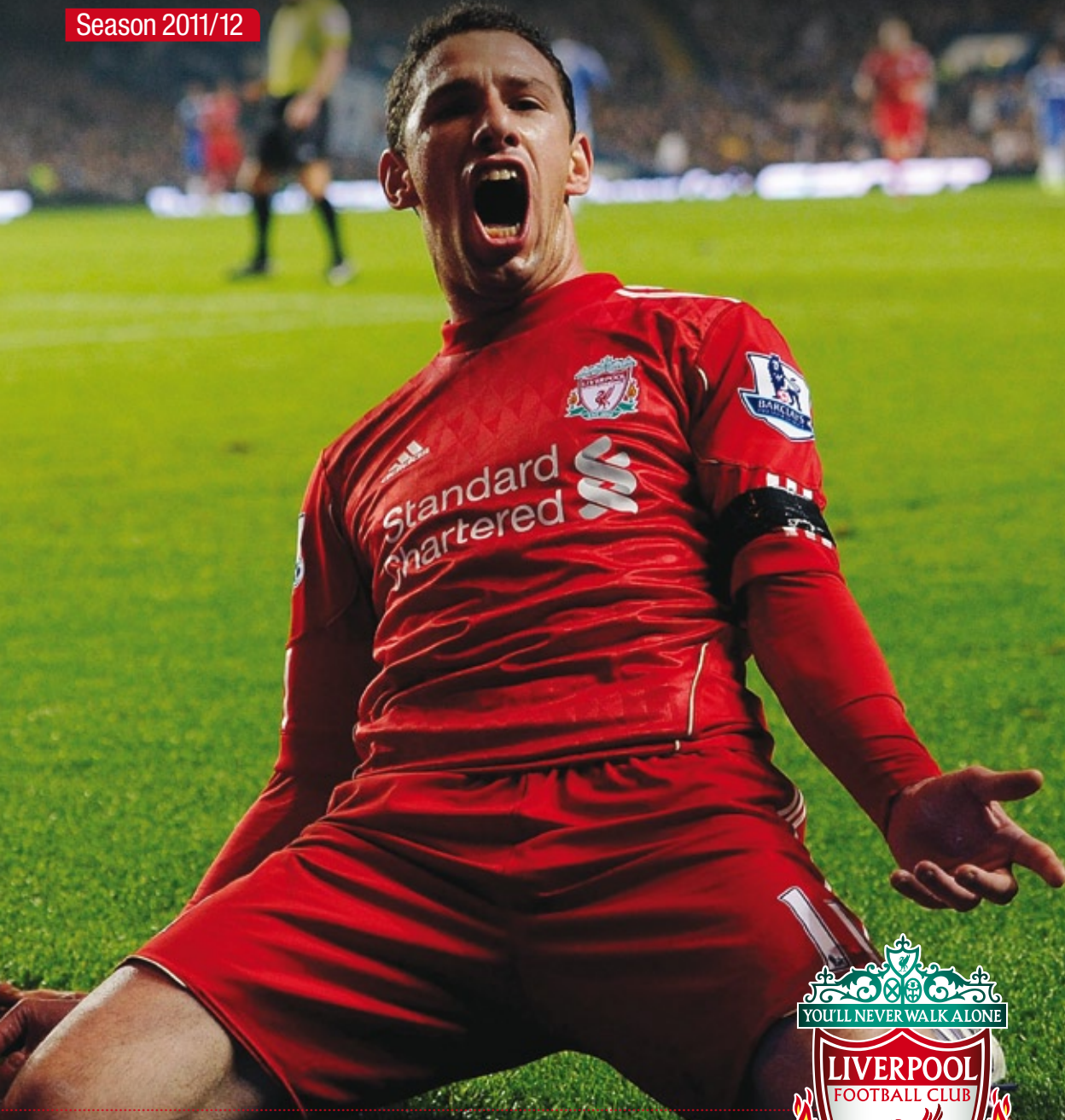

LIVERPOOL FC v CHELSEA FC

At Anfield: Liverpool 45 wins, 14 draws, Chelsea 9 wins.
Overall: Liverpool 63 wins, 28 draws, Chelsea 46 wins.

1. Earlier this season Liverpool won 2-1 in the league at Stamford Bridge. Maxi Rodriguez opened the scoring on 33 minutes with Daniel Sturridge equalising on 55 minutes. Glen Johnson scored the winner three minutes from time.
2. Last season Liverpool recorded their second Premier League 'double' over Chelsea. Today they go for their third, all within the last four seasons.
3. The Reds win at Stamford Bridge in November meant they recorded back-to-back league wins at Chelsea for the first time since 1974-75.
4. All of Liverpool's goals against the Londoners last season were scored by current Chelsea players. Fernando Torres scored both in the 2-0 Anfield win while Raul Meireles netted the only goal of the game at Stamford Bridge.
5. Both sides have won 16 of the 39 Premier League meetings with Chelsea scoring 47 and Liverpool 43.
6. Both Steven Gerrard in 2003 and Pepe Reina in 2006 have been sent off against Chelsea in the league, both times at Stamford Bridge.
7. Glen Johnson made his Chelsea debut against Liverpool in 2003. He went on to appear on 72 occasions for Chelsea in all competitions from 2003-2007 scoring four times.
8. Prior to last Saturday's Cup Final Steven Gerrard had scored once for Liverpool in 32 appearances against Chelsea. His strike in October 2005 came in a 4-1 defeat at Anfield.
9. Liverpool are looking to record a fourth successive league win over Chelsea home and away for the first time since August 1974.



10. Jordan Henderson made his career league debut against Chelsea in November 2008. His Sunderland team lost 5-0 at Stamford Bridge.
11. Kenny Dalglish has never lost to Chelsea as Liverpool manager in 11 league meetings with eight wins and three draws.
12. Patrik Berger scored Liverpool's last hat-trick against Chelsea at Anfield in October 1997 in a 4-2 win. Roberto Di Matteo was in the visitor's line-up that day.
13. Patrik Berger is one of four Liverpool hat-trick scorers in the league against the Londoners. The others were James Stewart (1910), Fred Pagnam (1915) and Gordon Hodgson (1930).
14. Liverpool's biggest league victory over Chelsea here came in April 1935 when they won 6-0.
15. There has only ever been one goalless draw between the sides in the league on this ground in 68 league meetings. It came on 9th October 1971.
16. The Reds have failed to score in only two of the last 31 home league meetings with Chelsea.

17. Liverpool are looking to record a second successive home league win over Chelsea for the first time since 2002-03.
18. Prior to the F.A. Cup Final, Jamie Carragher had made more appearances for Liverpool against Chelsea than any other Reds player (42), while Frank Lampard has made the most for Chelsea (35) against Liverpool.
19. Fernando Torres returns to Anfield for the first time since signing for Chelsea in January of last year. He scored seven goals in eight appearances for Liverpool against his current club.
20. Chelsea have won nine times on this ground in the league with four of those victories coming in the last eight years.
21. Prior to Saturday's Wembley clash Didier Drogba had scored 10 times in 27 appearances against Liverpool for Marseilles and Chelsea.
22. Salomon Kalou, John Obi Mikel, Fernando Torres and David Luiz all made their Chelsea debuts against Liverpool.
23. Raul Meireles scored five goals in 44 games for Liverpool while Fernando Torres' 142 games for the Reds saw him net 81 goals.
24. The Blues have scored six times against Liverpool in the last ten league meetings home and away.
25. Chelsea's last hat-trick against the Reds was scored by George Mills in August 1937 at Stamford Bridge.
26. The two draws in the 2007-08 league season are the only ones that have been played out between the sides in the last 21 Premiership meetings.
27. This will be the 32nd meeting between the clubs, including last Saturday's Cup Final, since the start of the 2004-05 season.
28. Chelsea are unbeaten in their last three away league games since losing at Manchester City in March. They won 4-2 at Aston Villa and drew 1-1 at Fulham and 0-0 at Arsenal.

29. Of Chelsea's five away league defeats this season three have come in the North-West – at Manchester United, Everton and Manchester City.
30. They have kept clean sheets in two of their last 11 away league games.
